Purpose of the Role:

This position is for a 12 month contract for a Research Associate, funded by the ESRC. The role of the Research Associate is to form a key part of the Lancaster University team in order to complete this research project. S/he will need to execute the recruitment of participants for a study on fetal responses to light, in addition to liasing with an external 4D scanning agency and participants. Attendance at scans will be required. S/he will need to interact with all team members in order to complete project objectives. The research team is spread across Lancaster University and Durham University.

Major Duties:
