- 3. Assist in participant recruitment and maintenance of a confidential participant database. You will manage confidential information provided by participants, and efficiently manage and catalogue large volumes of data in accordance with the ESRC LuCiD Centre's Data Management Plan.
- 4. Contribute to the ESRC LuCiD Centre's Impact Agenda, by assisting in arranging events for academic and non-academic partners (e.g. childcare and education providers, NHS partners, public engagement with science events, and local and national media).
