Major Duties:

Main duties. Based within the chemical engineering labs.

- To support the management of the Chemical engineering teaching lab including the housekeeping and maintenance of a safe working environment for lab users
- To provide technical support to users of other Chemical engineering labs.
- To record and, where appropriate, undertake the first line maintenance of equipment/resources.
- To provide technical assistance to academics and students in teaching labs.
- To assist with the sourcing of materials, chemicals and consumables.
- To advise staff and students on the correct operation of lab instruments, the design of experiments and good lab practice.

Health and safety.

- To ensure compliance with all relevant aspects of health and safety regulations and university policies whilst undertaking duties.
- To ensure that the Chemical laboratory users comply with relevant aspects of health & safety requirements and guidelines.
- To support the development of Chemical laboratory procedures and ensure users are trained in those procedures.
- To ensure that the Chemical laboratories and other areas that are assigned from time to time are kept in good order and safety devices are in place and operational.
- To ensure that all waste produced is disposed of in accordance with the relevant regulations and departmental and university procedures and policies.
