<p><b>Major Duties:</b></p> <p>Tutors will work under the direction of the Academic Director of Summer Programmes and the Academic Coordinators. Their duties will be as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To teach up to 25 hours per week. The actual number of hours will be decided by the Director and Coordinators and may vary from week to week.</li> <li>2. To be available from Monday to Friday for teaching and related administrative tasks, including meetings and to be available to engage in occasional social activities organised for students during the teaching weeks.</li> <li>3. To evaluate written assignments, timed writing tasks, and draft submissions, and provide students with detailed feedback in written, electronic form (via the course e-learning site) and in spoken form (during tutorials)</li> <li>4. To complete all paperwork (e.g. feedback on lessons and individual students) whenever necessary in a timely fashion, and to make all lesson notes and materials available to the Coordinators as required, in paper or digital form as requested.</li> <li>5. To follow the course syllabus as closely as possible.</li> <li>6. To attend meetings related to the course. These meetings will take place outside class times.</li> <li>7. To be available from 9.00am to 5.00pm during the week set aside for orientation and preparation of the course.</li> <li>8. To perform any further duties related to teaching, materials or administration of the course as may be required by the Director or Coordinators.</li> </ol>
