Major Duties:

- To perform experiments, analyse data, interpret results and present them at internal lab meetings.
- To develop new imaging and spectrophotometry methodologies, and new *C. elegans* strains for neuronal activity imaging and temporal mapping of neuronal activity.
- To contribute to the running of the research group, through technical training, and contributing to data and resource management in the group.
- To keep excellent records of activities carried out, both technical and managerial.
- To provide health and safety training to lab members, fill and update COSSH and risk assessment forms.
- To perform day to day management and animal husbandry of *C. elegans* and bacterial strains, while maintaining *C. elegans* and bacterial strain collections.
- To monitor lab consumable stocks, pass orders and manage lab budget coordinating with PI.
- To coordinate with PI and Chief Technical Manager for equipment maintenance, purchase and upgrades.
- To take responsibility for the maintenance, repair and safety, including keeping appropriate records, of the Benedetto lab equipment.
- To be the emergency contact for the Benedetto lab
- To be prepared to work occasional evenings / weekends if required.
- To provide technical training and assist PI with supervision of undergraduate and graduate project students.
- To attend lab meetings, journal clubs and internal seminars as appropriate.
- To proofread articles and grant applications.
- To contribute to outreach activities relevant to the funding body and the division, as deemed appropriate by the PI.
- To commit to undergo further training as deemed appropriate by the PI for the success of the project, as well as professional development, in line with Lancaster University policy.
