- Application Form Assessed against application form, curriculum vitae and letter of support. Applicants will not be asked to answer a specific supporting statement. Normally used to evaluate factual evidence, e.g., award of qualification. Will be "scored" as part of the short listing process.
- **Supporting statements** applicants are asked to provide a statement to demonstrate how they meet the criteria. The response will be "scored" as part of the short listing process.
- **Interview** assessed during the interview process by competency based interview questions, tests, or presentation etc.
