Major Duties:

To develop teaching within the Departments of Organisation, Work and Technology & Marketing.

Specific areas of activity include:

- To contribute to undergraduate teaching in the area of Management and Organisational Studies and Marketing at Lancaster University College at Beijing-Jiaotong University, and as appropriate also at Lancaster University's UK campus. This will include lecturing, tutorials, assessment and routine administration. At minimum there will be two periods of ten weeks each year spent at Lancaster University College at Beijing-Jiaotong University.
- To contribute to the development of new or revised courses and teaching modules in terms of structure, forms of delivery, methods of assessment, etc.
- To develop a scholarship program that informs teaching
- To engage with relevant stakeholders outside of the university, for example through executive education or through the activities of the Work Foundation
- Provide sabbatical cover for other academics' teaching where necessary.
- To engage in professional development opportunities, and obtain a relevant teaching qualification if not already held.
- To participate in the life and work of the departments, school and the university.
- To undertake any other duties (including administrative duties) as may be directed by Heads of the Department, as commensurate with the grade of the post.
