Major Duties: – For an initial period of three years to assume the position of Associate Head (Student Experience). This will entail: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Alongside the Head of School, the other Associate Heads of the School, and the Senior School Administrator, to form the School Leadership Team.○ To act on behalf of the Head of School on matters relating to the Student Experience.○ To review the allocation, and work of, academic advisors within the School.○ Design, and superintend the implementation of, a School Strategy for the student experience.○ In conjunction with the Associate Head (Quality and Standards) to have strategic responsibility for the enhancement of our teaching.○ To facilitate a ‘feedback loop’ between the School and its students, ensuring that students have a ‘voice’ in the activities of the School.○ In conjunction with other members of the School Leadership Team, to prepare, and react to, subject-level TEF.○ To assist the Head of School in the operation of the Workload Model.	

- To conduct Personal Development Reviews (PDRs) in support of the Head of School.
- Deputising for the Head of School when required to do so, including at Open Days and Applicant Visitor Days.
- The substantive role as Professor of Law, will have the following duties:
 - Contribute significantly to the development of the School through the generation of research, teaching and scholarship of international and world class excellence.
 - Pursue a high-profile personal research agenda in keeping with Research Excellence Framework (REF) criteria, leading to outputs/publications in key international peer-reviewed academic journals and other appropriate forms of research output and impact
 - Lead research teams or other collaborative research initiatives, departmental, inter-departmental, and/or inter-institutional.
 - Offer high-quality teaching on the School's existing undergraduate and postgraduate courses.
 - Contribute to the development of new courses or modules, individually and/or consorcially taught, and participate in ongoing development in all aspects of course structure, delivery, assessment, etc.
 - Attract and successfully supervise PhD candidates to completion
 - Play a leading role in the development of junior colleagues through leadership and mentoring in the areas of publishing, research funding and PhD supervision.
 - Engage in other duties appropriate to the grade of the post as required by the Head of School or Dean of Faculty
