Ability to develop an impact pathway that involves Ordnance Survey in knowledge transfer and industry engagement, software training, and outreach to government authorities, as well as IP capture.	Essential	Supporting statement/interview
Ability to lead communications with Ordnance Survey and different stakeholders through, for example, workshops and seminars for software demonstration and end product dissemination	Essential	Supporting statement/interview
Evidence of potential to secure additional funds and subsequent collaborations (e.g. Innovate UK and KTP)	Essential	Supporting statement/interview

- **Application Form** – assessed against the application form, curriculum vitae and letter of support. Applicants will not be asked to answer a specific supporting statement. Normally used to evaluate factual evidence eg award of a qualification. Will be “scored” as part of the shortlisting process.
- **Supporting Statements** - applicants are asked to provide a statement to demonstrate how they meet the criteria. The response will be “scored” as part of the shortlisting process.

- **Interview** – assessed during the interview process by either competency-based interview questions, tests, presentation etc.
