## **Major Duties:**

- 1. To conduct a literature review and synthesis of research in the area of youth comprehension, and develop a coding framework based on the literature review to be applied against investigative interview transcripts.
- 2. To support a range of experimental studies testing legal literacy amongst youth. This involves tasks such as assisting with designing experiments, liaising with local schools, recruiting and timetabling participants, collecting data, and setting up equipment where appropriate.
- 3. To support the dissemination of the research (e.g., peer-reviewed journal, conference presentation, stakeholder/funder reports, training materials).
- 4. Under the direction of your Line Manager make a significant contribution to the development of applications for future research grant funding.
- 5. To identify and engage in personal development opportunities to support your career development, including developing your personal research agenda; as provided by the Department, by the University, or by external bodies.
- 6. To work within the University's code of ethics and practice guidelines.
- 7.
