Ability to work independently, manage time efficiently and meet deadlines.	Essential	Supporting Statements
Publications record appropriate to stage of career including first author research publications in peer-reviewed journals.	Desirable	Application Form
Effective interpersonal skills and evidence of ability to work as part of a team.	Essential	Supporting Statements/Interview
To convey an appropriate rationale and interest in applying for this particular post.	Essential	Supporting Statements/Interview

- **Application Form** – assessed against the application form, curriculum vitae and letter of support. Applicants will not be asked to make a specific supporting statement. Normally used to evaluate factual evidence eg award of a PhD. Will be “scored” as part of the shortlisting process.
- **Supporting Statements** - applicant are asked to provide a statement to demonstrate how they meet the criteria. The response will be “scored” as part of the shortlisting process.
- **Interview** – assessed during the interview process by either competency based interview questions, tests, presentation etc.
