Major Duties:

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- To support the activities and management of the department's Mechanical Workshop (Conventional and CNC machine tool programming and operation, fabrication and assembly of parts, working from drawings, sketches and verbal instruction)
- To support the manufacturing & fabrication requirements of related projects and classes where they arise.
- Undertake where appropriate, maintenance of equipment & management of resources (materials, metals, tools).
- Liaise with suppliers and contractors on the servicing, repair and testing of lab. & workshop equipment.
- To maintain the store for teaching equipment to enable efficient changeover between projects and classes.
- Maintain up-to-date records of maintenance and testing of equipment.
- Assist with the sourcing of materials, consumables and equipment for the mechanical laboratories (first year laboratory, formula student, etc.) & workshop areas.
- To evaluate and test new equipment under consideration for use in the laboratories and workshops.
- To support academic staff in developing new laboratory demonstrations, project activities and practical sessions.

Health & safety:

- To ensure compliance with all relevant health & safety requirements whilst undertaking duties.
- To ensure that the mechanical laboratory users comply with relevant aspects of health & safety requirements and guidelines.
- To support the development of laboratory procedures and ensure users are trained in those procedures.
- To ensure that allocated areas are kept in good order and that safety devices are in place and operational.
- To ensure that all waste produced is disposed of in accordance with departmental and university procedures.

General duties:

- To assist with the raising of purchase orders, ensuring compliance with University financial regulations.
- To work co-operatively with the other members of the technician team in support of team, department and faculty objectives.
- To undertake any other duties as required, commensurate with the grade or below as directed by the Laboratory Superintendent or Head of Department.
- To undertake personal and professional development in accordance with the post requirements.
- To support the department's outreach activities with school, colleges and prospective students.
