- Supporting Statements applicants are asked to provide a brief statement (2-3 bullet points), giving examples from previous experience to demonstrate how they meet the criteria. The response will be "scored" as part of the shortlisting process.
- Interview assessed during the interview process by either competency based interview questions, tests, presentation etc.
