## Major Duties:

The key activities of the Research Fellow will be:

- 1. The overall efficient day-to-day management and delivery of EPHC research activities including:
  - a. Supervision and day to day support for the team's Senior Research Associates
- 2. To lead the co-ordination and development of research activities related to EPHC s work programme on topics related to upstream determinants of health (e.g air quality) and/or integrated health and care including:
  - a. Designing data collection tools and leading collection of data in research demonstration sites
  - b. Development of external networks
- 3. To develop and refine research protocols and lead ethical and governance approvals
- 4. To monitor the progress of the EPHC's research activities to ensure compliance with and adherence to project plans and to identify, evaluate and rectify problems including:
  - a. Working with the EPHC theme lead/manager and other team members and external ARC NWC staff to ensure efficient research management.
- 5. To lead the development of a research dissemination plan for the theme including:a. Preparation and coordination of reports/ dissemination of findings using other

appropriate media

- b. Publish outputs in high impact prestigious journals
- c. Cultivating knowledge exchange with internal and external partners/networks
- d. Presentation of the research at appropriate local, regional, national and international meetings and conferences
- 6. To identify sources of funding and lead/contribute to the preparation of research applications
- 7. To lead regular meetings specific to the theme or deputise for senior staff at meetings relevant to the research programme, including:
  - a. ARC NWC meetings including Programme Delivery and ARCFEST events
  - b. Relevant internal meetings of the Division of Health Research, and Faculty of Health & Medicine or wider university
- 8. To undertake any other duties as required by Head of Division or nominated representative or EPHC theme lead/deputy lead.
