Job Purpose:

To provide research support for the Horizon 2020 project, TARGETED-MPI (Transparent and Resilient Gender Equality through Integrated Monitoring, Planning and Implementation).

Duration: 42 months

TARGETED-MPI comprises international partners in Greece, Sweden, Brussels and Beirut and will develop greater gender diversity in Business and Management Schools. The four-year project will build knowledge and understanding of gender inequality in business and management (B&M) schools, develop strategic initiatives to drive more inclusive, sustainable and transparent academic cultures and effect institutional change through the development and effective implementation of Gender Equality Plans. We are establishing a European Network of Gender Equality Observatories to provide a best practice resource for B&M schools, thus ensuring the long-term sustainability of gender equality activities and initiatives.

Major Duties:

- 1. To support and undertake research activity to support the specified aims of the TAREGET-MPI project, as outlined in the Horizon 2020 proposal.
- 2. To undertake State of Art and State of Practice literature reviews.
- 3. To undertake in-depth empirical work with key stakeholders in LUMS, the University and externally.
- 4. To undertake analysis and interpretation of primary and secondary research and large complex qualitative datasets.
- 5. To liaise with and maintain good relationships with internal and external stakeholders.
- 6. To assist in the planning and development of project reports and contribute to the writing of publications and the dissemination of research findings including research papers, articles and newsletters.
- 7. To attend project meetings as required.
- 8. To assist in organizing and contributing to the stakeholder workshops and dissemination events associated with the project, including the development and management of the Gender Equality Observatory
- 9. To work closely with the Principal Investigator to develop an impact assessment framework and research record impact.
- 10. To actively engage and collaborate with the Principal Investigator and the ULANC team and external partners in the TAREGETED-MPI project in order to facilitate the work.

- 11. To actively participate in external networks that seek to promote research collaboration, further develop the area of gender equality and inclusion or seek sources of additional funding.
- 12. Any other duties commensurate with the grade and purpose of the post as required by the Principal Investigator.
