Major Duties:

Teaching

- 1. As part of a teaching team, deliver a range of established lectures, labs and workshops at undergraduate and masters levels.
- 2. As part of a teaching team, develop own teaching materials, with guidance, ensuring that defined learning objectives are met.
- 3. Undertake assessment activities and provide appropriate feedback to support student learning. This will be particularly focused across a range of first and second year courses but may also involve higher level undergraduate and masters courses.
- 4. Support Graduate Teaching Assistants to deliver seminars, workshops, and/or assessment activities.

Administration

- 5. To contribute actively and enthusiastically to the day-to-day running of the Department.
- 6. To undertake undergraduate administrative duties, as requested by the Head of Department.
- 7. To attend Departmental meetings and planning meetings and to contribute to student recruitment activities (e.g., Applicant Visit Days).
