Major Duties:

As Project Manager for the Chaplaincy Review project the role-holder will undertake a review of chaplaincy (as it relates to the provision of services and not the capital aspect of The Chaplaincy) to: i) review how effectively the current chaplaincy provision meets the spiritual needs of the diverse staff and student community of Lancaster University; ii) develop a set of recommendations for improving and enhancing chaplaincy provision for the future.

Responsibilities include:

- 1. Definition of project requirements and identification of all stakeholders.
- 2. Project planning including key milestones, project timescales and mitigations for missed deadlines or non-delivery.
- 3. Leadership of the assigned project team members and all internal and external stakeholders forming part of the wider project team involved in planning and executing the project.
- 4. Identification and prioritisation of stakeholder requirements and negotiation of schedule and deliverables.
- 5. Communication, influencing, negotiation and liaison with all internal and external stakeholders.
- 6. Take a pro-active and hands-on approach to delivering the project, leading on key project areas and engaging with internal and external stakeholders to develop evidence-based reports for the Project Steering Group.
- 7. Project control, resource management, resource negotiation and management reporting.
- 8. External engagement to ensure the project is informed by best practice both within and external to the HE sector.
- 9. Risk management.
- 10. Other duties as required.
