Major Duties:

- 1. Develop new understanding and guidance for promoting soil health and restoration on construction sites, and reducing soil losses to landfill.
- 2. Develop new understanding and guidance for the management of soil health and restoration based on observations and data collection
- 3. Responsible for maintaining and developing contacts with external stakeholders in the construction, planning and consulting industries
- 4. Work with partners to identify suitable sites for studying the impact of soil restoration practices from a soil functional and development perspective.
- 5. Engage key stakeholders to understand restoration needs and constraints and provide data about soil health.
- 6. Advise and contribute to discussions regarding research by other members of the wider team, including other Research Fellows, doctoral and Masters students;
- 7. Lead in the organisation of, and present their work at, quarterly meetings and workshops; the writing of research papers on the project
- 8. Participation in (and ultimately taking the lead in) writing new research proposals that build on the expertise in soils and the construction industry.
